- Mix of open- and closed-ended questions to allow for wide input
- Administer during the window of Monday, October 21 - Monday, October 28.
- Students will receive a link to the survey at school with time to complete the survey
- Families may opt their children out of the survey by contacting their school
- Staff will receive a link through email
- Families will receive a link through Skyward
- Community members can access a link through social media
- Data from the survey will be available in Early November
- Survey data will inform the direction for Focus Groups
